- Safety and Security. Fire drills are done monthly, we do tornado drills and lockdown drills. For evacuations, teachers will hold up red cards if they're missing a student; a green card if they are all accounted for. There is "Secure the Building" -- if there is something going on in the neighborhood involving police. School would go on as normal but no one would be allowed in or out, and all people in trailers would be brought inside. "Shelter in Place" is similar. If there is a hazardous material in the air, we stay in the building and operate as normal as possible but HVAC is shut down to prevent outside air from coming in. "Lockdown Drill" is for a threat within the building. They lock doors, cover windows, and move kids as far from the doors as possible. Will be doing a drill soon. If students are outside, teachers are instructed to go down the hill and wait for law enforcement.
- Spinny Johnson costs \$700, not \$675 as reported last month. 2 shows on Feb. 12
- May PTA meeting coincides with musical theater performance. Recommending that we have meeting on the second Thursday of May.
- Dome theater. Kids will go into inflatable dome. 20-35 minute grade-specific program (rockets, dinosaurs, Titanic, universe). We will need some volunteers -- 30 minute shifts to cover lunch and smaller children
