## Principal's Update

#### Lisa Reddel

- We are pleased to have Mrs. Redford filling in for our Vice Principal position. Mrs. Redford is still completing her administrative certification at this time therefore the position will be revisited at the end of the school year.
- Maggie Wilkerson is available to help with anyone who needs support during the government shutdown, particularly with school lunch needs. There are also job fair events occuring for anyone interested in subbing for Fairfax County Public Schools.
- New annual report is available on the website. We encourage new families to view it online to see all of the great opportunities at Sangster.
- VDOE has created a climate survey for all schools in the state of Virginia. The survey requires students in grades 4-6 and 9-12 participate. The FCPS K-12 principals requested Dr. Brabrand ask permission from the state superintendent for an exemption to <u>not</u> administer the survey to FCPS students due to some of the questions seeming inappropriate, which was granted. Therefore, all FCPS students will not be participating the VDOE survey. We are unclear how the survey data collected will be used. The parent and staff survey will still be ongoing.
- Every few years we do an emergency exercise called a Tabletop crisis (for example a shelter in place during a gas leak). We are having our exercise next Friday.
- The marquee is broken again. We will have to pay for the labor to fix the part but the part is under warranty.
- We have qualified for traffic calming on Reservation Drive. A committee will meet and put together a plan of the best way to proceed (ie. flashing school light, speed hump, etc).
- The budget was proposed to the school board at 3 billion dollars. The superintendent's number one priority is to increase teacher salary. The budget will then go through work sessions for approval. It includes the FCPSon proposal to move to one computer per student. They are still figuring out the best way to fund the computers for elementary schools so contact the school board if you have opinions to share.. More budget details are available online.
